PURO chooses to inspire

PURO Kraków Kazimierz, opened in Q3 2018, is filled with modern design and fresh approach. Minimalistic style and comfort that can be found in 228 rooms & apartments will satisfy all the creative and young at heart. The venue, located in Kazimierz – the Jewish district, can also host meetings (260 sqm of conference space). It is also the only hotel in Kraków to have its own bakery!

Golden Tulip introduces Metropolo

Kraków has been chosen to be the first city in Poland to own a hotel under Metropolo brand (opened in December, 2018). The stylish Chinese-art-déco-inspired interior has a great meeting potential. The hotel has 220 rooms and 16 conference rooms (2500 sqm in total). This makes it possible to host banquets for 1000 people or conferences for 2000 people. If we add a four-star-standard and in-house AV equipment to the equation, *Metropolo Krakow By Golden Tulip* may be interesting for many meeting planners considering Kraków for their event.
