Additional Information

The venue is entered in the register of historical monuments under the number A-90/M The fort will be leased out by open written tender on the following terms:

- The lease period up to 30 years;
- On condition that the activities carried out in the venue will allow anyone to visit and sightsee the historical site;
- The rent shall be paid in two annual instalments by 21st of June and 21st of December.
 The rent will consist of fees for the land and buildings
- The lessee will be obliged to revitalize the entire property.
