"Alrina" Barge

This original Dutch barge, built in 1889, is one of the biggest of its kind in Europe. After an almost one-year-long voyage, it found its way from Rotterdam to Kraków. Archeological Museum in Kraków

The Archaeological Museum in Kraków is the oldest archaeological institution in Poland, operating since 1850. It is located in the St. Michael complex. Between the 9th and the 13th century, wood-and-earth fortifications of Okół went through this area, while from the 14th century – a stone defensive wall surrounding the city. A monastery complex belonging to the discaled Carmelites stood there since the 17th century, and later, during the partitions, it was adapted into a prison by the Austrian authorities. The museum's collections include around 500,000 exhibits, which were uncovered during archaeological excavations and donated by discoverers and collectors. The Museum is an experienced organizer of banquets, concerts and social events. It cooperates with the best restaurants Kraków has to offer. The guests will have a big representative garden at their disposal, where tents can be set up and where one might create an interesting light arrangement or construct a concert stage.

Bishop Erazm Ciołek Palace

Branch of the Historical Museum in Kraków

The Palace was built between 1501 and 1503 for the Bishop of Płock, Erazm Ciołek, chancellor to the king Alexander Jagiellon. Bishop Ciołek was a diplomat, humanist and a patron of arts. Traditional Gothic attributes (pillars in the entryway) and influences of Italian Renaissance (main portal) are visible in the building's architecture.

Bunkier Sztuki

Contemporary Art Gallery

The building, in which Bunkier Sztuki Contemporary Art Gallery is located, is one of the few Polish examples of brutalism. Until 1990s, it was the only modern architectural building in the Old Town area. Integrating Exhibition Pavilion with its historical surroundings and introducing concepts dictated by functionalism was possible thanks to including the localization context in the design project. The building was designed by Krystyna Różyska-Tołoczko (1909-2001) and the façade, made of concrete castings of wooden boarding – by Stefan Borzęcki and Antoni Hajdecki.

At the moment, Bunkier Sztuki has three autonomous exhibition areas: Lower Gallery for small projects, and rooms on the ground floor as well as on the first floor, meant for group exhibitions and elaborate projects. Bunkier Sztuki also has a Project Room, dedicated to exhibiting small, individual projects.



Celestat

Branch of the Historical Museum of the City of Kraków

The building called Celestat (a shooting range, from German *Zielstätte*) located in the Shooters Garden is the historical residence of the Fowler Brotherhood. The Neo-Gothic palace was built in 1837. The Brethren Room was its main part. In 1874-1875, a huge room was added to the Northern wall, called the Shooters' Room, measuring 320 sq m in area and 6 m in height, split in half by Neo-Gothic colonnade. In the modern times, the 19th century interior of the Shooters' Room was recreated to a large extent, including the vaulting dominated by a frieze decorated with portraits of Kraków's marksmen kings. The Brotherhood's symbol and the most important royal insignia – silver fowl – is displayed in the middle of the room. Unique gifts presented by abdicating kings and memorabilia, cups and trophies are displayed before the fowl. Royal marshals' and Brotherhood's authorities' insignia: sceptres, staves and chains of office are presented separately. The Brethren Room contains documentation of the more modern history of the Fowler Brotherhood. As the Brotherhood is still active, this part of the exhibition is regularly changed and updated. Here you will also find memorabilia showing the Brotherhood's roots in the Catholic faith and culture, as well as close and cordial bond between the Brotherhood and the Pope John Paul II – honorary member of the Fowler Brotherhood.

Collegium Maius Museum of the Jagiellonian University

Collegium Maius, is the oldest university building in Poland. In the year 1400, king Władysław Jagiełło granted the townhouse to the university, which had been bought from Kraków's town councillor. Its remnants are visible in foundations and at the corner of the building (from the side of the Jagiellońska street and the courtyard) in the form of the so-called wild limestone wall, typical for the 14th century. The townhouse was not spacious which is why Collegium expanded over the 15th century by buying neighbouring buildings and building a few more. In the wake of the fires in 1462 and 1492, the buildings were combined into a harmonious complex, creating the arcaded courtyard encompassed by cloisters, and a late Gothic crystal vaulting, at the same time. On the ground floor there were lecture halls. The library (Libraria), professors' common room (Stuba Communis), the vault and theological lecture hall (today's Auditorium) were located on the first floor. The professors' quarters - or residences - were located on the ground floor as well as on first and the second floors. Appearance and character of Collegium changed dramatically during the 1840-1870 Neo-Gothic remodelling, as the purpose of the complex changed: it was now the home of the Jagiellonian Library. In 1949-1964 the Collegium Maius regained its original appearance from before 1840. The building was also repurposed to serve as the seat of the Jagiellonian University Museum and the home to old university collections.

Collegium Novum

of the Jagiellonian University

The building of Collegium Novum at the Jagiellonian University, currently used as an office of rectors and deans of the oldest university in Poland, was constructed between 1883 and 1887 in accordance with a design prepared by Feliks Księżarski. The Neo-Gothic lecture hall, which is the heart of the building, was where academic year inauguration was celebrated until 2004. At present, it is where next generations of graduates and doctoral students are promoted. In the centre of the room, on a high podium, the armchairs of the rector and vice-rectors are exhibited, while deans' armchairs are located to the side. The front wall is decorated with portraits of the founders of the Jagiellonian University, while other walls are decorated with two monumental works of Jan Matejko (including the well-known *Astronomer Copernicus, or Conversations with God*) and portraits of outstanding professors of the university.

The historic interior of the lecture hall perfectly frames numerous conferences, academic meetings and concerts. It is also a valued filming location. Collegium Novum is where lecture hall 66 is located (currently 56, Józef Szujński lecture hall), which was the place of the tragic *Sonderaktion Krakau* on 6 November 1939.

Franciscan Monastery in Kraków

The basilica and the monastery are located in the oldest part of the city. The edifice was built in the 13th century, which is why the floor level is lowered – it reminds us about the medieval layout of the streets in Kraków. Over the centuries, the monastery's Gothic chambers were the venue of meetings of kings and sessions of regional councils. The goldsmiths' guild had its chapel here. After 1989, the monastery hosted presidents of Germany and Poland as well as participants of international conferences on human rights. At present, monastery chambers serve as the venue of conferences, seminars, workshops, science and business meetings as well as festive galas and concerts that do not disturb the historic and spiritual atmosphere of the place.

at the Jagiellonian University
Collegium Medicum

The Museum of Pharmacy is located in a historic townhouse located in the downtown of Kraków, at Floriańska 25. Its exhibition occupies all five floors of the building, starting with Gothic cellars (including 16th century alembics for distillation and barrels for medicinal wines) and finishing in the attic (medicinal herbs and exhibits used for drying and storing them). Other rooms are used to display furniture from historic pharmacies in various styles (including furnishing from former monastic pharmacies), a palatial collection of Majolica from European manufactures, medicine ingredients of animal origin (including human fat, a mummy, Spanish flies and centipedes) and mineral origin (chalcanthite, cinnabar) as well as old medicines (original dose of legendary teriak), pharmacy paraphernalia (capsules for coating pills with gold and silver), old herbaria, pharmacopoeias and other prints on apothecary history.

It's famous for old Polish recipes, aromatic meats, especially venison and poultry, wild mushrooms and fresh fish. The richness of Polish ingredients, cooker's craftsmanship and exceptional interiors – it all makes Wierzynek a culinary symbol of Kraków!


